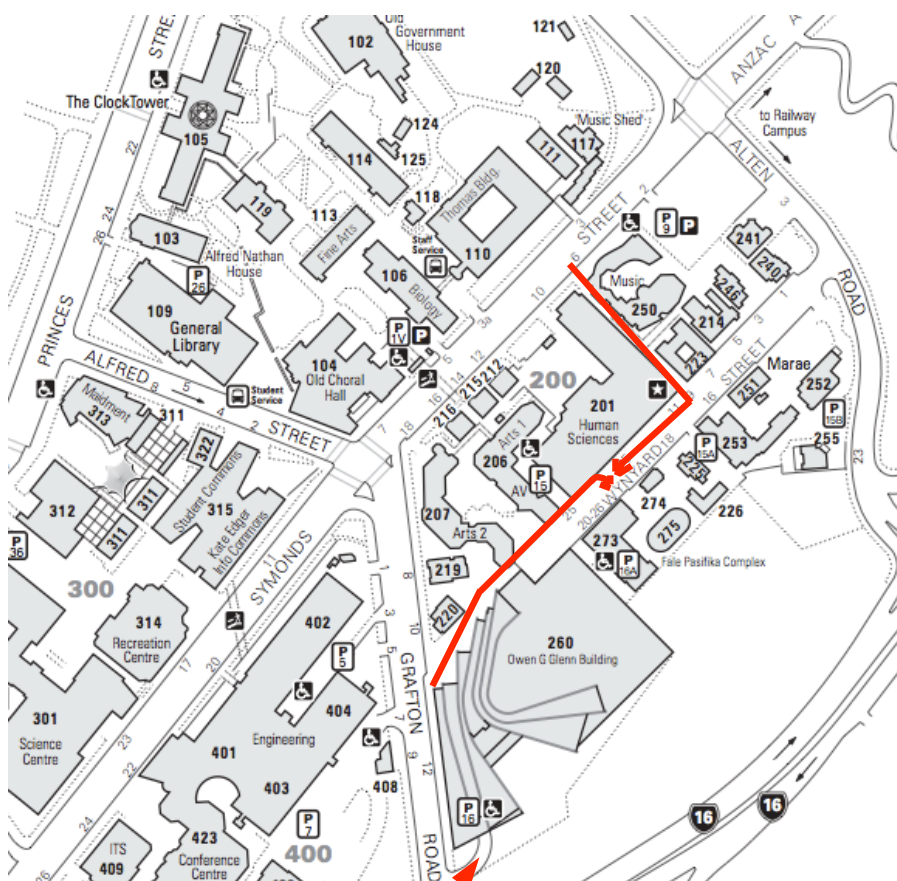

Directions

From Grafton Road, outside the Owen G Glenn Building, walk through in front of the Commerce C building and then down the stairs onto Wynyard Street. Ours is the small L-shaped building to the right a little further on, building 273 as shown below. To enter, continue around to the far side and come through the automatic door.

From Symonds Street, walk down the path between the Human Sciences Building and the Music School, then turn right into Wynyard Street, walk along to Building 273 and enter through the automatic door.



The entrance to the Owen G Glenn Building carpark is accessed from Grafton Road, and is also the entrance to the Fale carpark. To park beneath the Fale Pasifika, enter the carpark and stay on the entrance level. Drive straight through past the lifts and disability parks. Casual parking for visitors is available at \$4 an hour on weekdays.
